Verification of Income Information for Student (and Spouse if Married)

Complete top section if taxes filed/will be filed; complete the bottom section if no taxes will be filed

Instructions: Complete this section if the student and spouse filed or will file a 2017 IRS income tax return. *The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool that is part of FAFSA at FAFSA.gov.* In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2017 income information that was transferred into the student's FAFSA using the IRS DRT if that information was not changed by the FAFSA filer.

In most cases, for electronic tax return filers, 2017 IRS income tax return information is available for the IRS DRT or the IRS Tax Return Transcript within 2–3 weeks after the IRS income tax return has been accepted by the IRS. For paper filers it can take 6-8 weeks. If the student and spouse filed separate 2017 IRS income tax returns, the IRS DRT cannot be used and the **2017 IRS Tax Return Transcript(s)** must be provided for each.
