**Note:**

- Criminal Justice majors are required to maintain a 2.25 average in major core and concentration courses.
- Students are required to Select one of the following undergraduate concentrations and take 9 credits in that concentration:
  - Law and Justice
  - Corrections
  - Police Administration
  - Investigative Sciences and Profiling
  - Criminal Research and Intelligence Analysis
  - Cybersecurity and Computer Forensics (exception: take 18 credits)
- Specializations are also required for the Master's degree program (12 credits for the Thesis MACJ Program, 15 credits for the non-thesis MACJ Program) To provide targeted expertise, the program offers three unique specializations in Criminal Justice Administration, Global Criminal Justice, and Cybercrime Investigation and Cybersecurity
