- **NJ State Financial Aid**: If you are an NJ Dreamer (a resident who was brought to the United States as a child without documentation and meets all the criteria) and are not eligible for financial assistance under the (FAFSA®), you may still be eligible for state financial aid through the New Jersey Alternative Financial Aid Application.
