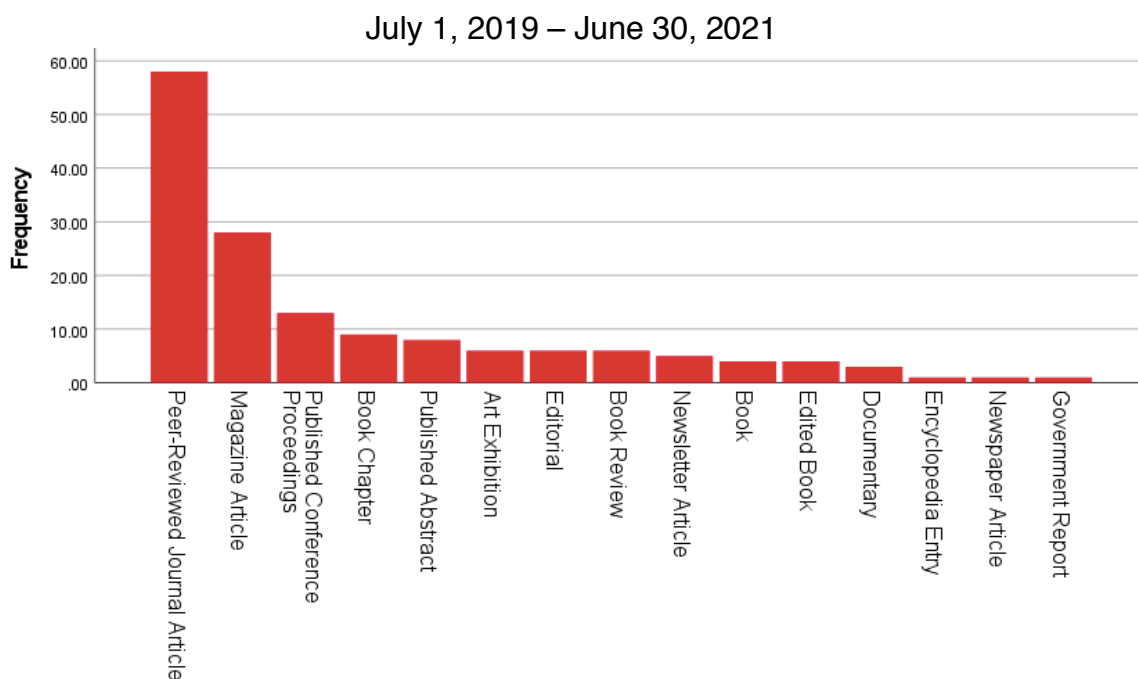
**Brittany Hanson, Ph.D.**

## Scholarship

This year the booklet includes three years of publications since we skipped the event last year due to COVID, but to be consistent with previous years only two years (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2021) of products are included in the figure. The products included 58 peer-reviewed journal articles, 28 magazine articles, 13 published conference proceedings, 9 book chapters, 8 published abstracts, 6 art exhibitions, 6 editorials, 6 book reviews, 5 newsletter articles, 4 books, 4 edited books, 3 documentaries, 1 encyclopedia entry, 1 newspaper article, and 1 government report for a total of 153 products. Fifty-three members including three librarians, one dean, and one professor emerita faculty member, from ALL departments contributed at least one product.
